## HOW TO: CONNECT TO CAMPUS NETWORK ON MAC



1. Connect your Apple Computer to the university's network via a wireless (DolphinNet) or wired network connection.

2. When choosing DolphinNet, a prompt will appear asking for your JU network username and current password. (this will be the username and password you use to sign into the My JU website) If you are using a 'Wired' connection please proceed to step 4

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3. Please make sure the check mark for "Remember this Network" is selected. And click JOIN.

4. Once the computer is connected to DolphinNet or connected via a wired connection, please open Safari or Google Chrome.

5. Once Safari Chrome is opened, please try to go to a site you have not visited before. Good one to try will be www.cnn.com or <u>www.espn.com</u>, or even the my.ju.edu log in page.

6. The following webpage will appear:

7. Click on the Download Now button and a program will download.





8. Once this program has downloaded, you will need to run (open) it. Once you open it, you will get the following window:

9. Go through the installer like you are installing a new program. The software WILL ask you for the password for your computer in order to install. Once the installation is done, you will see the following window: 11. Click the CLOSE button on this window and on Safari (Your Web Browser) you should see the following page:

12. Click "I'm Done Installing

Please note: to connect to out network you must have an antivirus installed. If you do not have an antivirus already, then you will be prompted to download one after selecting "I'm done installing"

15. The application will download and can be found in the top right of your browser

16. Open the download and the following pop up will appear, double click the "install avast security" and the following will appear, select "allow"





17. Proceed to then follow the installation instructions, pressing continue and if prompted to provide credentials for settings, log in with your computer credentials and continue.







18. Once the installation is complete, you will be prompted by Avast itself for a few more final set up steps. Press "continue" 19. Follow the proceeding instructions for the avast installation.

20. Once completed you will be successfully connected to the network.
