



## Experiential Learning for Life Scholarship

The Office of Experiential Learning (EL) is offering twelve scholarships to support Experiential Learning in the following areas: **Study Abroad/Away, Undergraduate Research, Service-Learning, and Internships**. Scholarships are intended to foster post-graduate preparation for students who are pursuing their Experiential Learning options.

### **Eligibility:**

- Must be traditional undergraduate student.
- Must be applying for an EL program that is for credit.
- Must secure a faculty sponsor who approves the overall project. Students may also have a faculty member submit a letter of recommendation.
- Projects must be completed by the end of the summer 2023 term.
- **Please Note:** Although scholarships are disbursed in the spring semester, students who have participated in an EL project during the fall semester are eligible for the scholarship

**Selection:** Scholarship applications are reviewed by a committee from Experiential Learning and awarded through Financial Aid.

**Number of Awards:** 4      **Award Amount:** \$500

**Number of Awards:** 8      **Award Amount:** \$250

**Application Deadline:** Tuesday, February 28, 2023

**Announcement:** Scholarship awardees will be notified by email 2 – 4 weeks after the deadline submission date. An official award letter will be issued to the recipient from the Office of Experiential Learning. The EL Office will only notify award recipients, not all applicants.

**Disbursement:** The funds will be disbursed to the recipient through the Financial Aid office during the Spring 2023 term. Students chosen for the award must be enrolled at JU during the Spring 2023 semester. **If students who receive scholarship money have an unpaid bill at JU, the money will first be applied to the outstanding bill.**
