3. **Consumerism in health care will continue to rise with greater transparency of price and outcomes.**

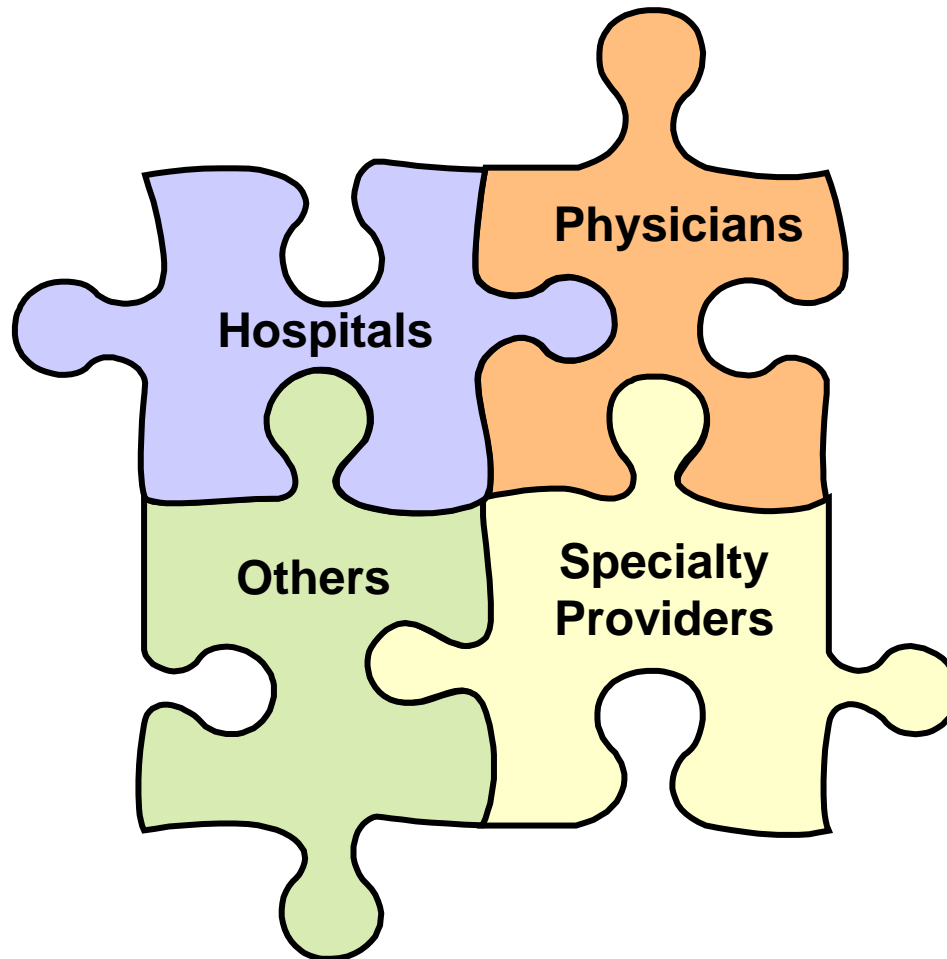
# Assumptions for Health Care's Future
